The ongoing issue of speeding cars in the village was discussed alongside the speed survey results and the costs of speed signs and power issues considered. Fund raising to part fund the erection of a sign would be needed due to the cost implications. It was proposed that parishioners would need to fund raise for half the amount which would be approximately £2000

Resolved: To approve and note the decision to consider raising the funds for a speed sign if Parishioners were in favour of contributing 50% of the cost, with the Parish Council finding 50% of the amount.
